2. Do you think Jack taking the blame for the test was a sacrifice made out of guilt or out of integrity?
3. Brad seemed unaware of the possible consequences of stealing and distributing the test. What do you think this says about Brad?
4. How do you feel about Becca? Do you think she was manipulative when it came to men, or simply naïve when it came to her affect over them?
5. Do you think Brad misconstrued Becca's feeling for him, or do you think Becca led him on?
6. Kelsey feels a deep connection to Becca. Why do you think that is?
7. Do you think Kelsey found closure for herself? If so, what events brought that closure?
8. Why do you think it was so important for Kelsey to deliver Becca's journal to the Eckersley's?
9. Are you interested in Kelsey's future? Including what's next for her at *Events Magazine*, her relationship with Peter, and (despite triumphantly running past The Spot) what will be discovered about her attacker?
10. The book was written to slowly reveal the mystery surrounding Becca Eckersley, including several surprising twists. Which were the most shocking?
